1st GRADE WORDS TO KNOW FOR THE SAVIOR BOWL

Adam - the first man that God made.

Alleluia – a word that means “Praise God”.

Believe – to accept that what someone says is true, even if you have never heard it before.

Christmas - the birthday of Jesus.

Easter Sunday – the day that Jesus rose from the dead.

Eve – the first woman that God made.

Faith – a gift from God that makes us able to believe in all that God tells us.

Grace – the life of God in our souls.

Guardian Angel - a special angel given to each person by God that helps to take care of them.

Holy Communion – the Body and Blood of Jesus that Catholics receive during Mass.

Original Sin – the very first sin committed by Adam and Eve.

Prayer – talk to God.

Priest – a man who has received the power from Jesus to forgive sins and offer Mass.

Promise – when you say you are going to do something and you really mean it.

Sacrifice – a way to show God how much we love Him by giving up something that we like.

Sign of the Cross - The shape that we make by touching our forehead, chest, and shoulders. This shows that we believe that Jesus died for us.

Sin – saying “no” to God.

Ten Commandments – the moral laws that God gave to Moses on Mount Sinai. These laws tell us how to live as God wants us to live.
