### **3<sup>rd</sup> GRADE WORDS TO KNOW FOR THE SAVIOR BOWL**

**Ascension** – when Jesus went back to Heaven forty days after He rose from the dead.

**Baptism** – the sacrament which takes away original sin. It gives us God's grace, incorporates us into Christ, and makes us children of God.

**Bishop** - a man who does the work of the apostles and takes care of a large group of Catholics.

**Calvary** – the hilltop where Jesus died.

**Christian** – a baptized follower of Jesus Christ.

**Communion of Saints** – the unity of all the members of the Church here on earth with those in Heaven and in Purgatory.

**Disciple** – a follower of Jesus.

**Examination of Conscience** – thinking about what we did to see if it was good or bad in preparation for confession.

**Host** – the round wafer of bread used at Mass. At the Consecration it is changed into Jesus, the Bread of Life.

**Last Supper** – the dinner Jesus had with the Twelve Apostles the night before he died.

**Miracle** – something wonderful that is done by the power of God and that only God can do.

**Parable** – a story that teaches a lesson.

**Pentecost** – the coming of the Holy Spirit to the apostles.

**Purgatory** – the place where a soul goes to be made clean from all venial sin and receive punishment due to sins already forgiven before it can go to Heaven.

**Religious** – men and women who are dedicated to God in a special way.

**Savior** – Jesus Christ, who died to save us all from sin.

**Worship** – love, honor, and adoration which we give to God.
