5th GRADE WORDS TO KNOW FOR THE SAVIOR BOWL

Annunciation – God's announcement to Mary through the Archangel Gabriel that she was chosen to be the Mother of the Son of God.

Apostles' Creed – a prayer that contains the chief truths of the Catholic faith.

Assumption – the taking up into Heaven the body and soul of Mary.

Blasphemy – speaking about God in a scornful or irreverent way.

Cardinal – a person, usually a bishop, selected by the Pope to belong to a special group in the leadership of the Church.

Catholic – universal.

Evangelization – spreading of the gospel message.

Free Will – the ability to make a choice.

Immaculate Conception – the special privilege that God gave to Mary by which she was free from original sin from the first moment of her life.

Magnificat – Mary's song of praise to God.

Marks of the Church – the four characteristics of the Church by which it is recognized as the Church of Christ. One, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church.

Passover – the Jewish feast commemorating the deliverance of the Israelites from Egypt.

Pentecost – the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles.

Resurrection of the Body – the rising of the body to be reunited with the soul at the end of the world.

Revelation – the truths of the faith which God has made known to us through Scripture and Tradition.

Tradition – the handing on through the centuries of the whole of divine revelation, including the truths contained in Sacred Scripture.

Transfiguration – the glorious change in Jesus appearance when he revealed something of his divinity to Peter, James, and John.

Trinity – three divine persons in one God.
